





Born in Żywiec, Poland in 1977, Fr. Kos was raised and educated in Poland. After graduating from high school, he worked as a nutritionist for 5 years. At age 24 he joined a Catholic seminary in Krakow. After three years of studying philosophy and theology, Fr. Kos left Poland for a seminary in Austria where he continued his studies for two more years. In 2006 he moved to Chicago, IL to study English at the University of Illinois . In 2007 he made his final educational move to Orchard Lake, Michigan to continue priestly formation at SS. Cyril & Methodius seminary. Fr. Kos was ordained in May 2010 and serves the Archdiocese of Hartford, Connecticut.
