# **Saint of the Month - St. Andrew**

Andrew was the first disciple to be called by Jesus. Andrew met Jesus and did not hesitate to follow Christ; he told his younger brother Simon (Peter) about Jesus. One moment, he and his brother were casting their nets for fish, the next, they were with Jesus sharing the gospel and performing miracles as "fishers of men."

Jesus commissioned Andrew with the other eleven apostles, equipping him to preach and heal in His name. In the feeding the 5,000, it was Andrew who called attention to the boy with the five loaves and two fishes, which Jesus used to perform the miracle.

As the early church grew, Andrew shared the gospel in Scythia and Greece, fulfilling the Great Commission to "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit..." St. Andrew, by following Christ, extinguished in his heart all earthly passions and desires, and in doing so, attained the happiness of His pure divine love.
